
SCHOLARSHIP

Easter 2018 Journey to the Holy Land

An opportunity is available for a part scholarship for a young Wagga Wagga person (aged 16-25) to be part of the South Wagga Anglican Church tour to Israel, Jordan and Palestine during the Easter School Holidays 2018.

The aims of this trip are:

1. To build an appreciation of the original land and context into which Jesus lived.
2. To connect our Christian faith to the historical events of 2000 years ago.
3. To build our friendship and community up as we travel together.

There are two part-scholarship available. The full price ticket to attend is \$6290. This includes airmiles, accommodation (including breakfast and dinner), all tours and entrance fees, border fees and visa, tips and gratuities etc. A single supplement (if you are not sharing accommodation) applies if the applicant chooses - this is \$1425. Travel insurance will also be required. The only other money required will be to cover lunch each day and any personal shopping one may wish to do.

There are two part scholarships available to the value of 50% of the full ticket price, i.e:

\$3145

Successful applicants will be required to place a \$350 deposit with Olive Tree Travel.

A current passport is required. If the applicant is under 18, they will require parental permission and appropriate guardian arrangements to be organised. An interview with parents may be required.

Applicant should apply in writing by the 15th August, and fill in the attached application form, and return to the South Wagga Anglican Office at St. Paul's.

Preference will be given to those in financial need, and young people who are members of the South Wagga Anglican Community, although others may apply. Successful applicants may be asked (upon their return) to share their tour experience within the South Wagga Anglican Community.
